Re: Prospective VET students for 2024

Dear Families

After attending the Post School Pathways camp and through work done in Exploring Identities and Futures (EIF), your child has indicated a desire to undertake a VET course in 2024. Information about the course they have expressed interest in has already been sent home for your appraisal. A brief overview of those courses is listed below. For further information, please click on the following link to access the 2024 VET for School Students Guide (refer to the page indicated below next to the course).

As VET is an elective pathway, the College will cover up to \$500 per student (course fee only). The remaining VET fees will be charged to families. Please note that prices are subject to change with funding allocation from the government. Prices below are exclusive of possible College rebate.

Courses may run on a weekly basis or for week-long blocks.

Current courses on offer in Port Augusta

- Cert II in Automotive Servicing Technology (approx. \$360) (currently week-long blocks) p40
- Cert II in Construction pathways (approx. \$440) (currently each Monday) p11

Current courses on offer in Whyalla (possible Port Augusta – if enough numbers)

- Cert II in Electrotechnology (approx. \$570) p12
- Cert II in Engineering pathways (approx. \$380) p41
- Cert II Salon Assistant (approx. \$370) p25

Current courses on offer Blended (mix of online & face - possibly in Whyalla or Adelaide)

Cert III in Early Childhood Education & Care with 160 hours of work placement (approx. \$400) – p20

Courses which have not yet been confirmed for our region (more likely Whyalla than Port Augusta)

- Cert III in Individual Support Aging/Disability (approx. \$1500)- p22
- Cert II Hospitality (approx. \$200) p36

If your child has interest in the courses in Whyalla/Adelaide, it will be the family's responsibility to provide transport.

Please note that some courses require students to sit an aptitude test before they are accepted. This will take place late in Term 3.
