SCHOOL CARD HOLDERS

These fees are for families approved under the School Card Scheme. An application must be completed each year through the College. Without notification of eligibility, families will be charged full fees unless other arrangements have been made.

DISCOUNTS

Early Payment Discount

Families choosing to pay all fees in total by 28 February 2021 will receive a 3% discount off the total fees.

Sibling Discount

The following discount is given to families with more than one student at Caritas College:

- second child 20% off annual tuition fee
- third child 75% off annual tuition fee
- fourth & subsequent children 100% off annual tuition fee

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Caritas offers families a number of ways to pay fees. These are cash, cheque, direct deposit, BPAY, EFTPOS, Paysmart.

Please note the Caritas College School Fee Policy, including the requirement for payment of annual fees to be finalised by 31 December.

VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING (VET) FEES

VET fees are in addition to school fees and families are responsible for payment prior to commencement of courses. VET courses are offered by external providers and fees are determined by the providers. Costs vary and details are available from our VET Co-ordinator.

WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE FEES

Camps, Retreats and Excursions

These activities are all inclusive within the fee, and are not refundable if you choose not to attend.

Stationery

The fee structure has been extended to include the supply of stationery items for all students. Families are not required to order or purchase stationery items. Stationery items will be supplied and distributed to Students on the first day of school in 2021.

Student ID Cards

A student ID Card is included in the school fees for Year 7 – 12 students however, there is a cost of \$5.00 for a replacement card if needed.

Text Books

Textbooks are available for borrowing through the Library. Unreturned and damaged books will be charged to family accounts.

Laptops & Carry Bags

In 2020 we completed the implementation of the 1:1 Laptop Program for all students in Years 7-12. Each student completes a user agreement, outlining the use and care expectations, before receiving the laptop, no additional fee is charged for the laptop unless damaged or stolen. The laptop remains the property of Caritas College. It must be stored in the case provided at all times and returned to the College on completion of your child's education with us.

Student Printing

Students receive a printing credit dependent upon the year level of each student each term. The College has an ongoing vision to improve and develop technology along with environmental sustainability by reducing paper and using more online learning for sharing of work. Additional credits can be purchased from the Finance Office if needed each term.

School Care Insurance

The College provides a school activities and excursions cover. This cover is designed so that anytime students are on school related activities the policy will provide 24-hour cover for Students' Personal Accident and Disability policy through Catholic Church Insurance. Ambulance Cover
