- Shirt with sleeves to elbows – NO TANK TOPS (preferably long sleeved and with a collar)
- Shoes that can get wet and muddy
- Shorts or board shorts over the top of bathers are highly recommended , to prevent sunburn and for ease of movement getting in and out of boats
- A packed recess, lunch and water bottle
- Towel
- A jumper or spray jacket
- A change of clothes
