#### 2021 School Fee Schedule

As shared in recent newsletters, the 2021 School Fee Schedule is now available on our website. We are proud to offer an affordable and accessible Catholic education to all families. We invite families to contact the College if you have any questions regarding fees or your personal financial circumstances. Please be aware of the following features of our School Fee Schedule for 2021:

<u>No increase of school fees for the last two years</u> There was no percentage increase to fees in 2020. Furthermore, there will be no increase to school fees in 2021.

#### 1:1 Laptop Program

In 2020, we commenced a 1:1 Laptop Program for all students in Years 7-12. The cost of this device is included within the School Fee Schedule. Therefore, families do not incur any additional costs for this educational resource that supports their learning at school and at home.

#### **Stationery**

The fee structure has been extended to include the supply of stationery items for all students. Therefore, families are not required to order or purchase stationery items at the beginning of each school year as these are supplied by the College.

#### **Class Placements for 2021**

Teaching staff have spent considerable time and effort placing students into classes for 2021. A range of factors are considered and inform these placements which include:

- Progress of learning
- Student's individual needs (Social/emotional, learning, physical, behavioural)
- Relationships
- A balance of sexes

Sometimes other factors may also need to be considered. Please be assured that the process for class placements focuses on the overall learning and wellbeing needs of each student. Class placements will be communicated to parents during the week prior to school starting next year. This will happen via an email detailing your child's teacher and classroom. A text message will also be sent alerting you that this information has been emailed to you.

#### **New Uniform**

The front office has been abuzz this week with families coming in to try on the new uniform. I thank families for their patience as we work through the big process of implementing the new uniform. I especially thank the front office staff for the incredible work they have done in supporting families through this process over the past week. Please know that the current uniform will still be able to be worn throughout 2021 and 2022 while we transition to the new uniform.

#### Uniform Update.....

Earlier this week, we were advised of some recent developments that have affected deliveries of some uniform items.

The recent escalation in shipping congestion has added 2 - 3 weeks to delivery times. This is a worldwide issue that has compounded as pre- Christmas sea freight during October and November has been at an all time high.

All Summer Sportswear items will be available to order mid January. [as indicated on the Online ordering site]

Winter items such as Track pants, Girls pants and Rugbies will be available second term. [ as indicated on the Online ordering site]

Unfortunately, the Online Ordering platform will not allow for families to place an order for those items where there is No stock available. Families may prefer to hold off placing an online order until **11 January** when more stock becomes available.
