NAPLAN

Students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 will be involved in Literacy and Numeracy Testing, (NAPLAN Tests) between $11^{th} - 21^{st}$ May. It is important that your child attends school on these days. These tests provide useful data for individual achievement in comparison with national standards and are a means of identifying particular needs at each year level. Please see you child's teacher if you have any questions about NAPLAN testing.
