Dear Families

During Term 3, students in Year 8 Gold will be partnered up with Mr Muirhead's Year 12 PE class and partake in a coaching program to help them improve their understanding and skills in volleyball. Students will be split up into teams and will be coached by the Year 12 students in the roles of tactical and technical skill development. Lessons will be treated like a normal sporting season where students will remain separated in their teams, improve their skills through training sessions, be given feedback by coaches which is then implemented into trial games, regular season games and of course finals.

All lessons will be filmed, and evidence/data collated will be used by the Year 12 students to complete their AT3 assessment task worth 30% of their grade and marked externally by SACE. This evidence will be incorporated into a 12-minute PowerPoint Screen cast presentations and will be sent straight to SACE and will not be viewed by any other entities.

Being involved in such a program means that the term will primarily be practical lessons only, meaning that in this term the health curriculum will not be assessed due to the lack of lesson time availability. Students are asked to wear their HPE uniform on Wednesday and Friday and should have a water bottle for all lessons.

It goes without saying that this assessment task is vital for the Stage 2 PE results of the Year 12 students, therefore positive participation, cooperation, and engagement is required at all times.
