Re: NAP Information Communication Technology Literacy (NAP-ICTL) – Assessment Thursday 8 May

Dear Families

In May 2025 samples of Year 6 and Year 10 students in schools in all Australian states and territories will participate in the NAP Information and Communication Technology Literacy (NAP-ICTL) sample assessment, one of a set of assessments within the National Assessment Program. The National Assessment Program is an ongoing program of assessments designed to measure progress towards the goals outlined in the Melbourne Declaration on Educational Goals for Young Australians, 2008.

Your young person has been selected to participate in the NAP-ICTL assessment. This online assessment will be conducted on the Thursday 8 May and be administered by Mrs Fiona Antonic. Students do not need to study or prepare anything in advance for the NAP-ICTL assessment.

Following the assessment ACARA will provide the school with reports of the performance of students as a collective. Information regarding individual student performance is strictly confidential and no individual student or school information will be published.

School and student participation is essential to ensure that NAP-sample tests are high quality and error-free, and that they provide accurate and reliable outcomes. Consequently, all sampled schools and students are required to participate in these activities unless they meet exemption and withdrawal criteria stipulated in the NAP protocols.
