- ☐ All students need to wear correct HPE uniform and ensure they pack their school hat
- ☐ Apply sunscreen
- ☐ Whistle
- ☐ Students with pre-existing injuries asked to bring their own strapping/braces

As per the College's updated mobile device policy, all personal devices must be turned off and kept in bags for the duration of the carnival or handed in to staff at the start of the day, smart watches must be switched to flight mode. Students will not be permitted to use these at any point during the day until our return to school/event dismissal.
