Dear Families

After attending the Post School Pathways camp and through work done in Exploring Identities and Futures (EIF), your young person has indicated a desire to undertake a VET course in 2026. Information about the course they have expressed interest in has already been sent home for your appraisal. A brief overview of those courses is listed below. As VET is an elective pathway, the College will cover up to \$500 per student (course fee only). The remaining VET fees will be charged to families. Please note that prices are subject to change with funding allocation from the government. Prices below are exclusive of possible College rebate.

Courses may run on a weekly basis or week blocks.
